
We are so excited you are here.

This fall in Rise Collective we are leaning into prayer. Prayer is central to a life of faith in Christ. As women participating with God and His Kingdom here on Earth, we want to pursue His presence.

So, where do we begin to grow our prayer lives?

We want to open God's Word and look at Jesus. We want to learn from how he prayed. Over the course of the next 6 weeks we will read through passages of scripture and observe Jesus-learning from the way he retreated, the way he talked to the Father, and the vital role of prayer in his life and ministry.

Before you begin reading, think about creating a rhythm for your time meeting with Jesus everyday.

A few questions to help you prepare for your daily time in scripture over the next 6 weeks:

- -What time will you set aside each day to meet with Jesus and open the Word?
- -Where will you meet with Him for your time in God's word? Maybe it's a chair or a bench or a corner of your space. This is sacred time. Mark out a location that you know will be where you go each day.
- -All you really need is your Bible, a journal and a pen. God is going to speak as you listen. We want to write down what He is teaching us.
